Fact Sheet – Best Practice Locations

Best practice tour: Royal Seaport



Stockholm Royal Seaport has good prospects of becoming an international prototype for sustainable and high quality urban development. The area runs along the waterline of the Baltic Sea, lies next door to the Royal National City Park and is just ten minutes away from central Stockholm by bicycle. The industrial site around the gasworks area, the 236-hectare site is due to be transformed into a major new city quarter by 2030, providing Stockholm with 12,000 homes, 35 000 workplace and a new cultural district. It intends to become an urban district that interacts with port operations and the existing residential areas. Planning work started in the early 2000s and the new city district will be fully developed around 2030. The district will be adapted to future climate changes as well as safeguarding biodiversity and ecological values. A resource efficient area with low environmental impact.

Best practice tour: Årsta GrowSmarter projects



Årsta is a district of Stockholm located about 4 km south of the city center. Årsta has been selected to participate in the GrowSmarter Smart City project (SCC1 H2020)) where multiple urban innovation solutions are to be implemented. These solutions include energy-efficient building refurbishment, smart lighting, smart waste collection and an urban logistics center.

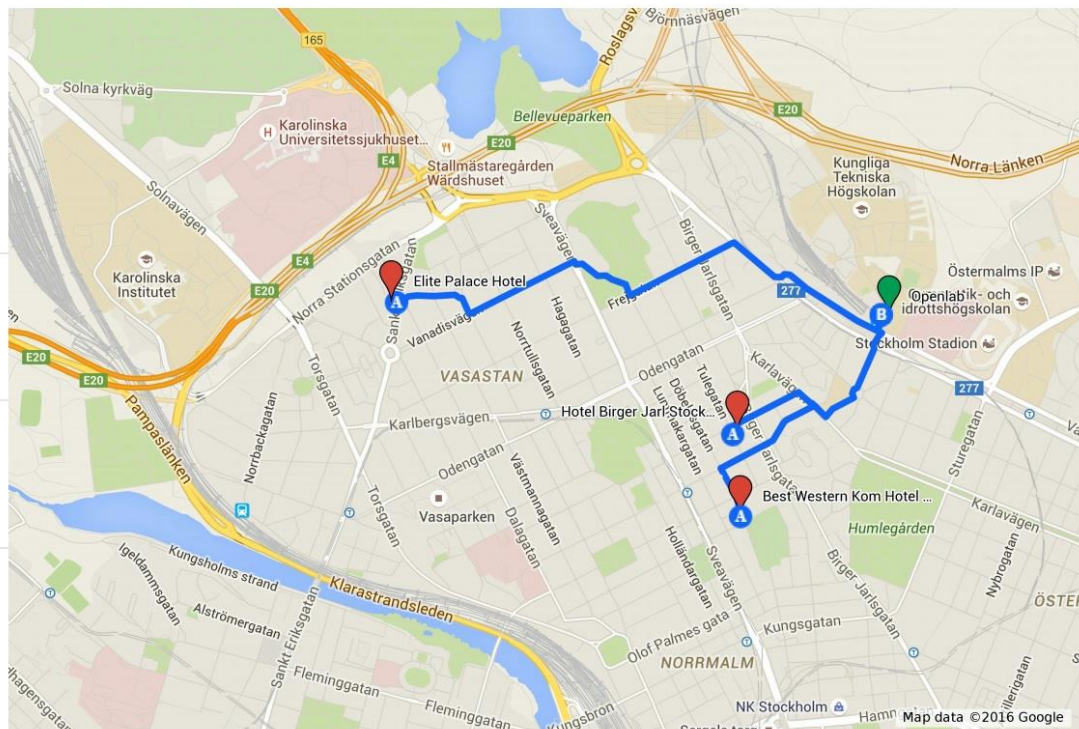
